## A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:



So what are you getting for Jesus this Christmas? Is He on your Christmas list? We make our lists of who we're buying gifts for, hoping and praying we don't forget or overlook anyone, but let's not forget that it's Jesus' birthday we're celebrating. What could we give Him?

Do we overlook Jesus on the very day we celebrate His coming? We get so busy this time of year at church, or in the kitchen at home, or buying gifts to go under the tree, and we fail to think about our Lord and Savior. We don't mean to, or choose to, or
