#### A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:



Genealogies and family histories have always been important to the Jewish people. So as a Jew writing to a Jewish audience, Matthew naturally opened his book with a genealogy. To show that Jesus was the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies about the Messiah, Matthew had to prove that Jesus was a direct descendant of David with a rightful claim to the throne. He traced Jesus' ancestry through Joseph, his legal father, and

ended at Abraham, verifying that Jesus was one of God's chosen people.

The list of forty-six people in Matthew's list includes a motley crew. Even more striking, Matthew included the names of several women, something that Jewish genealogies normally did not do since ancestry was traced through men. When we really look close at Jesus' genealogy, we find people like Tamar, the woman who tricked her father-in-law to impregnate her by dressing like a prostitute; we find David, who slept with his friend's wife and had him killed to cover it up; we find Ruth, a Moabite, not even Jewish; There's also Rahab, not only a foreigner, but a prostitute; then we see in the list Manasseh, one of the most wicked and godless kings in Israel's history. Jesus' line is filled with outsiders of every kind. So, if you think you have a dysfunctional family, take a look at Jesus' family tree. Some of the most unsavory characters in human history made it into the most exclusive genealogy. However, the real message in the genealogy of Jesus is that God can change your story. No matter how many skeletons are in our closet, no one is outside God's grace unless he or she chooses to be there. Even if you've made a mess out of your life, He can redeem it. Jesus's story is not about God helping perfect people; it's about God saving lost people. Jesus came to heal broken lives and restore shattered hopes. He came to save us from our sin.



#### Nursery and Children's Church Ministry:

Nursery/Preschool Ministry Team: This ministry focuses on nurturing and teaching our young children about the love of Jesus Christ. These volunteers rotate on a regular basis as they serve in our nursery and preschool ministry each Sunday morning during worship. Children's Church: A team of 2 volunteers will present a Bible story video and then discuss the story. Easy right!

#### Rootz Student Ministry:

Youth Ministry Team: This ministry focuses on helping our teenagers grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ as well as with other Christians. There are various opportunities to serve in an on-going role in this ministry.

#### Wednesday Night JAM Ministry:

On Wednesday nights all students meet together for a meal, worship and Bible study. We currently need individuals in all areas, especially in the preparation and caring out of the Wednesday nigh meal.

#### Joy Garden's (Just Older Youth)

Our senior adults make up this ministry. Currently they are meeting once a month for food and Christian fellowship.

#### **Transportation Ministry Team:**

This ministry provides transportation for those who need assistance to attend our worship services.

#### <u>Greeter/Usher Ministry Team:</u>

<u>Greeters:</u> The Welcome Team strives to set a Christian example of the Body of Christ as members of God's family by giving guests a warm and comfortable welcome. They provide guests with information about the church and place them in appropriate Small Group Bible studies.

<u>Ushers:</u> These men help with taking up the offering and passing out bulletins with a smile to make everyone feel welcome. <u>Security/Patrolling Ushers:</u> This ministry provides security during Sunday worship services for our building and our parking lot.

#### Sunday School and Small Group Bible Studies:

Our small group Bible studies are the foundational strategies for helping people to grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ and with other believers. There are various groups for all ages. Sunday School meets at 9:45 am and Men's Bible Study on Wednesday morning. We are in urgent need of toddler and baby Sunday school teachers

#### Sound/Audio Visual Ministry Team:

This ministry helps with worship services/events/meetings by providing quality sound and audio-visual enhancement. Training will be provided so experience is not necessary.

#### **Choir and Musicians:**

The Choir leads worship in the Sunday morning worship services. If you sing or play an instrument this could be the place for you!

#### Women on Mission:

This essentially encompasses the "women on mission" of the church. Project JFK (Our ministry to John F. Kennedy Elementary) and the Operation Christmas Child (Shoebox Ministry) are just a couple of the mission opportunities our women take on each year.

#### **Brotherhood:**

The purpose of this ministry is to plan mission/ministry projects and fellowships that bring men together and reach out to our community.

#### **Outreach**

<u>COA Team</u> (Community Outreach Activities): This team helps our church to plan and implement various creative outreach events such as Trunk and Treat, Spring Fling, and more.

<u>Card Ministry:</u> This group writes cards to guests and members as a way to provide encouragement and follow up from our church. <u>Food Ministry Team:</u> This ministry provides food for members during times of grief.

<u>Grief Ministry Team:</u> This ministry provides assistance/ministerial care to our members during times of grief. They help during times of grief by organizing meals, prayer support, counsel, and visits of support and encouragement.
