OUTSIDE SECURITY GUIDELINES

1. Begin duties as close to Sundays 9:45 AM and 5:45 PM as possible. During morning services remain outside until all outside doors have been secured, (usually by Bill Thurman about 11:15 AM). A set of keys to outside doors are in the vestibule.

During evening services remain outside until at least 7:00 PM.

Monitor for any unusual/suspicious activities and seek assistance as quickly as possible.

DO NOT CONFRONT ANYONE WITHOUT ASSISTANCE UNLESS IT IS AN EXTREME EMERGENCY.

When necessary call 911 for Police assistance.

- 2. If you are unable to make your scheduled date, try to find another security person to swap dates with you. If that is not possible, contact either Paul Bowman 423-247-8834 or Allen Rhoton 423-247-9009.
- 3. Carrying a weapon is up to individual performing duties; however, you must have a State/Federal Carry Permit and ability to safely use it.

If carrying a firearm do so responsibly and discreetly. It is an awesome responsibility.
